Please read through these instructions and ensure they are kept for future reference.



Instructions for Use

- 1. Insert one "AA" type alkaline battery (not supplied) into the battery compartment on the rear of the clock. Ensure correct location of battery noting polarity identified in the battery compartment.
 - 2. To set the time; rotate the time set wheel at the back of the clock to the desired setting.
 - 3. Remove battery before storing the clock. A worn-out battery can damage your clock.

Changing the Batteries - Batteries should be removed and replaced by adults only.

- Only use recommended batteries or those of the same or equivalent type.
 - Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types.
 - Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
 - The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
 - Remove exhausted batteries from item.
- Remove batteries if equipment is not used for extended periods of time.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the item before being recharged.
 - Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
 - Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Batteries contain substances that may be harmful to the environment and human health.
 - Keep out of the reach of children and seek immediate medical help if swallowed.
