Settling in: A Guide To Your New Furniture

IMPORTANT

- For ease of assembly, we advise that two people work together, as parts can be heavy.
- Assemble your new furniture on a non-abrasive surface, such as a dust sheet or the original
- cardboard packaging.
- 1. PREPARATION
- Clear a large, flat area for assembly.
- Unbox all parts and check against the provided parts list.
- 2 ASSEMBLY
- Ensure that all screws and fittings are loosely attached before tightening.
- We advise using only hand tools. Power tools can damage your new furniture.
- Avoid over-tightening screws, as this can lead to damage.
- 3. HANDLING
- To move your new furniture, always lift it. To avoid breakages, do not drag pieces across the floor.
- 4. CARE
- To maintain the condition of your furniture, avoid using abrasive or corrosive cleaning agents.
- · We suggest using a garden furniture cover when your furniture is not in use to keep it clean and protected.

ASSEMBLY ADVICE

- Complete Before Use: Ensure the product is fully assembled before use.
- · Child Safety: Keep small parts out of reach of children.
- Leg Positioning: Make sure all legs are securely fitted and in full contact with the ground.

CARE & MAINTENANCE:

• To ensure the longevity of your furniture, we recommend following the care Guidance outlined below:

FURNITURE CUSHIONS

- Storage: During extended periods of non-use or adverse weather conditions, store your furniture cushions in a dry
 and well-ventilated indoor space. Ensure all cushions are clean and completely dry before storage.
- Inspection: Regularly check cushions for signs of mould, mildew, or damage.
- · Spillage Management: Address any spills immediately using an absorbent sponge or cloth to prevent staining.

TABLE TOPS

- Protective Measures: Always use coasters to shield table tops from heat and water marks.
- Careful Handling: When tilting the table, exercise caution to avoid loosening the ceramic or glass surface.
- Immediate Cleanup: To prevent permanent stains, clean up any spills right away.
- Cleaning: we recommend using a glass or multi surface cleaner along with a soft sponge

RATTAN & SYNTHETIC ROPE

- Debris Removal: Use a soft brush to remove leaves and garden debris. For dirty marks on the rattan, clean with a non-abrasive sponge and lukewarm, detergent-free soapy water, then rinse with fresh water and allow to dry.
- Protective Cover: We suggest using a garden furniture cover when your furniture is not in use to keep it clean and protected.

ALUMINIUM

• Cleaning: Clean the aluminium frame with a non-abrasive sponge and warm soapy water, then rinse with a hose.
