Tide Clock Operating Instructions

HOW THE TIDE CLOCK WORKS

The moon is the major cause of the tides and a lunar day is 24 hours and 50 minutes. This clock is designed so that it rotates once every 12 hours and 25 minutes (twice each lunar day) and will stay in exact step with the moon. There are other factors that make the tides a little earlier or later than the tide clock shows, including local wind and weather patterns, abnormal atmospheric pressure and solar activity during different phases of the moon cycle. To minimise these variations it is important to follow the instructions below when first setting your tide clock.


IMPORTANT: When setting up for the first time, it is important that you set the tide position, when your local high tide occurs on the same day as a full moon.

TO SET THE CLOCK

- Move the hand to 'HighTide' position by rotating the 'Set Knob'
- Insert 1 x AA battery into the battery compartment on the day of a full moon at exactly the time of the high tide according to local tide tables. Take care to observe the polarity on the battery.

 Set in this manner, your tide clock should be correct to within 30 minutes.



CHANGING THE BATTERY

- It is recommended that you replace the battery annually even if the product is still running
- Only use AA (1.5V) alkaline batteries in this clock
- Please dispose of used batteries in a responsible manner

MAINTENANCE

A soft cloth may be used to clean your clock. Do not use any corrosive cleaner or chemical solutions on the clock. Keep the clock clean and dry to avoid problems.

Waste electrical products should not be disposed of with household waste.

Please recycle where facilities exist. Check with your Local Authority or retailer for recycling advice.
